Privacy policy

I. GENERAL PROVISIONS

The Administrator of the personal data is TALEX S.A. with its registered office at ul. Karpia 27d, 61-619 Poznan, hereinafter: the Administrator.

II. SCOPE OF COLLECTED DATA

TALEX S.A. processes personal data only to the extent necessary to fulfill a well-defined purpose based on relevant legal grounds. The scope of data processed by TALEX S.A. is indicated below.

CONTACT section

- first and last name
- e-mail address
- telephone number
- company name
- data included in the sent message

CAREER section

- first and last name
- e-mail address
- telephone number
- all other data included in the application documents

In addition, in order to allow the User to use the Website and all its functionalities correctly and safely, the Administrator uses technologies that collect and process data stored using cookies, including IP address (for details please see the Cookies Policy).

III. PURPOSE AND LEGAL BASIS FOR DATA PROCESSING

Personal data shall be processed for the following purposes:

- 1. answering a question directed to the Administrator via the contact form, available in the CONTACT section, on the basis of the Administrator's legitimate interest (Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR) consisting of building and developing positive relationships with Users based on reliability and loyalty;
- 2. sending marketing content, including commercial offers, on the basis of voluntary consent (Article 6(1)(a) of the GDPR);
- 3. recruitment, including:

The User's personal data shall be processed by the Administrator pursuant to Art. (1)(c) of the GDPR - based on the right resulting from Article 22^1 of the Polish Labour Code, and Article 6 (1)(a) of the GDPR – within the scope of personal data not specified in the point above, or if the User agreed for their personal data to be processed in future recruitment based on their expressed consent, pursuant to Art. 6 section 1(f)
